

Website Smartphone Detection

Simply follow the instructions below to activate a popup which prompts visitors on mobile devices to install your App from their App Store.



1. Your Website Footer

Copy and paste the following code into your website's footer (just before the `</body>` tag). The only editing you need to do is to replace **"Your App's Google Play Link"** and **"Your App's iOS App Store Link"** with the links to your app in the appropriate stores.

  let getParam = window.location.search.substring(1);  
  if( getParam == 'app_link' ) {  
    jQuery.cookie("mobileDownloadLink", "opened");  
  } else {  
    var isMobile = { Android: function() { return navigator.userAgent.match(/Android/i); }, iOS:  
function() { return navigator.userAgent.match(/iPhone|iPad|iPod/i); } };  
    if( jQuery.cookie('mobileDownloadLink') == "opened" ) { /*DO NOTHING*/ } else {  
      if( isMobile.iOS() ) {  
        jQuery("#mobileAppDownload a").attr("href", "YOUR APPLE LINK");  
        jQuery("#mobileAppDownload").css('display', 'block');  
        jQuery.cookie("mobileDownloadLink", "opened");  
      } else if( isMobile.Android() ) {  
        jQuery("#mobileAppDownload a").attr("href", "YOUR GOOGLE LINK");  
        jQuery("#mobileAppDownload").css('display', 'block');  
        jQuery.cookie("mobileDownloadLink", "opened");  
      }  
    }  
  }  
</script>

2. Your CSS File

Now all you have to do is copy and paste the following code into your sites CSS file. You can customise the colours to match your branding if you want to.
